## MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDER, U.S. ARMY MEDICAL RESEARCH AND MATERIEL COMMAND

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority for Department of Defense (DoD) Executive Agent Responsibilities in Support of Medical Research for Prevention, Mitigation and Treatment of Blast Injuries

## 1. References:

- 2. On 21 August 2017, the Secretary of the Army delegated to me the authority to act on his behalf for any and all DoD Executive Agent (EA) responsibilities, functions and authorities for the Medical Research for Prevention, Mitigation and Treatment of Blast Injuries assigned to him in reference 1b.
- 3. Pursuant to paragraph 3 of reference 1d, I hereby delegate to you my authority to act as the DoD EA Responsible Official for the Medical Research for Prevention, Mitigation and Treatment of Blast Injuries, and to act on my behalf for all DoD EA responsibilities, functions and authorities assigned to me.
- 4. Although not a limitation of your authority to act on my behalf as the DoD Executive Agent, I trust that you will exercise sound judgment in keeping me informed of any actions under this delegation that will have significant White House, congressional, Department of Defense or public interest or would represent a significant change in Army precedent or policy. If such circumstance arises, coordinate with me to ensure I can provide appropriate guidance.
